We've raised funds for the walls and part of the roof for the second school building at Galilee Church. Ten thousand bricks have been purchased and placed at the site, waiting for our arrival. Cement will be purchased in February. We're so excited to be working toward completion of the first United Methodist School in the District, the Complexe Scholaire Jane Wise! *If you have not already given, please consider a gift in 2018 toward this important project. \$8,000 is still needed to complete the roof, windows, doors and floors.*
